### What is the program?

AgFood Connect is an innovative pilot project that aims to create full-time jobs for individuals across a multitude of businesses in growth industries, making the employment process simple for jobseekers and employers. Being a part of AgFood Connect offers employers and jobseekers access to case-managed employment and employees, ongoing mentoring, and expert staff that are available to you seven days a week. Our staff aim to overcome any barriers that you may face in the employment and recruitment sectors.

### What are the Employment Services on offer?

With a full suite of services under AgFood Connect, the program offers services in:

- » Recruitment: We make recruitment easy, by giving you access to fully trained and supported employees as well as the support of our expert staff.
- » Training: We provide an individually tailored training and support plan, PaTH EST training that may include industry skills such as Farm Ready card, white card, forklift, plant tickets and other accredited training.
- » Labour Hire: Our labour hire services ensure short, medium and long-term staffing with expert administration of HR, payroll, inductions, WHS, WorkCover and claims management.
- » Apprenticeships and traineeships: This allows you to host two or more employees at the one time through apprenticeships, traineeships, casual or permanent employment.

### What are the eligibility requirements for a jobseeker?

- » Be aged 17-24 years
- » Be in jobactive
- » Transition to Work
- » Disability Employment Services or NEST
- » Be eligible for Youth Jobs PaTH Internship (*See PaTH Internship Guidelines for full details*)
